Bay-Friendly gardeners work with nature to reduce waste and prevent pollution of local creeks, waterways and San Francisco Bay. Saturday, September 27: Bay-Friendly Gardening Basics, 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m.

Considering form and function before planting can save you time and resources. This workshop will provide an overview of design and maintenance considerations and practices that will help you make smart choices at the nursery. \$25 (or \$60 for the series of three)

Saturday, October 11: Gardening from the Ground Up, 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m.

Healthy soil is the foundation of a healthy garden. Understanding your soil will help you grow a blossoming garden this season and for seasons to come. Backyard composting, sheet mulching basics and other soil building techniques will be covered during this workshop. \$25 (or \$60 for the series of three)
