

## **NOTICE FOR EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL**

### **To All Concerned Parties:**

This is an advisory letter to all construction related projects in unincorporated Marin County. All disturbed surfaces, including but not limited to cut and fill slopes, building pads, driveways, and areas of cleared vegetation, shall be protected against erosion by best management practice measures appropriate for the site, phase of construction, and weather conditions. All such measures shall be completely implemented by October 15 and shall be maintained and modified to remain effective throughout the rainy season, which ends on April 15.

*Failure to properly implement and maintain erosion and sediment control measures may result in grading prohibition, building inspection “holds”, or other action as determined by the County of Marin.*

All erosion control materials needed to implement these measures shall be on site by October 1. Plan ahead, as material shortages may occur as the October 15 deadline approaches. Specific control measures shall be in general accordance with the “Manual of Standards for Erosion and Sediment Control Measures” published by the Association of Bay Area Governments. Note that other agencies, such as the Regional Water Quality Control Board, may have additional requirements.

County Department of Public Works staff will begin inspections to verify measures are in place during the 1<sup>st</sup> week of October. We are also available to answer questions. Please call (415) 499-6530 and ask for the Land Development Area Engineer assigned to your project.
