

**The Marin County Flood Control and Water Conservation District completed the Woodacre Creek Fish Passage Restoration Project at Carson Road in January of 2009. The project is located in the unincorporated community of Woodacre.**

Woodacre Creek Restoration at Carson Road- For adult and juvenile salmon the primary problem at this site was the small, undersized pipes, which created a serious velocity barrier for fish attempting to swim upstream to spawn. Inside the culverts, salmon also encountered a lack-of-depth during low flows, which prohibited juvenile salmon from moving downstream to cooler waters during dry summer months (June 2007).

Figure 3. The completed project spans the channel, making the “road crossing virtually invisible to the stream”, while providing unimpeded access to adult and juvenile salmon moving up and downstream through the watershed (January 2009).
